Dr. A. K. Pandey, Dean of the college highlighted the importance of bamboo in North-east India and the benefits of bamboo cultivation in Sikkim to increase the farmers' income. He highlighted the importance to Bamboo artifacts in various regions of North-east regions and also gave detail information on the various bamboo germplams of Sikkim and importance of it's conservation in Sikkim. Dr Pandey said that India has abundant



diversity of bamboo genetic resources after China and about 25% of bamboo species of the world are found in India distributed widely in almost in all the states. Sikkim has rich genetic wealth of bamboo and it occupies 8 genera and over 30 species. While mentioning the several industrial uses of bamboo, he highlighted the growing business of Indian Agarbatti Industry

which has exported its products to countries worldwide with staggering revenue that was close to Rs. 1000 crore. India's Agarbatti Export Industry has shown an upward spike at a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 15% and is expected to cross Rs. 12,000 crore mark in next 5 years. Further, he mentioned that bamboo species, *Bambusa tulda* which is most suitable for stick making has abundant scope for cultivation in the Sikkim state.



Mr. Nima Dawa Tawang, Bamboo Handicraft Entrepreneur encourages the youths and students of the college to take up entrepreneurship for self-reliance and employment. He also highlighted the value of bamboo artifacts in the market and benefits of taking up bamboo ventures. Mrs. Saraswati Sharma, Vice President, Bermiok GPU gave immense importance on development and encourage bamboo cultivation to the farmers.
